The tram makes a lot of noise!

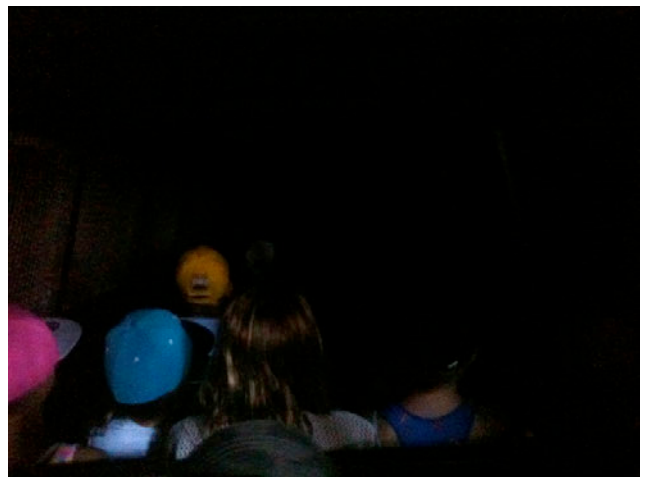
This is to make it seem scarier than it really is.

.....and darker

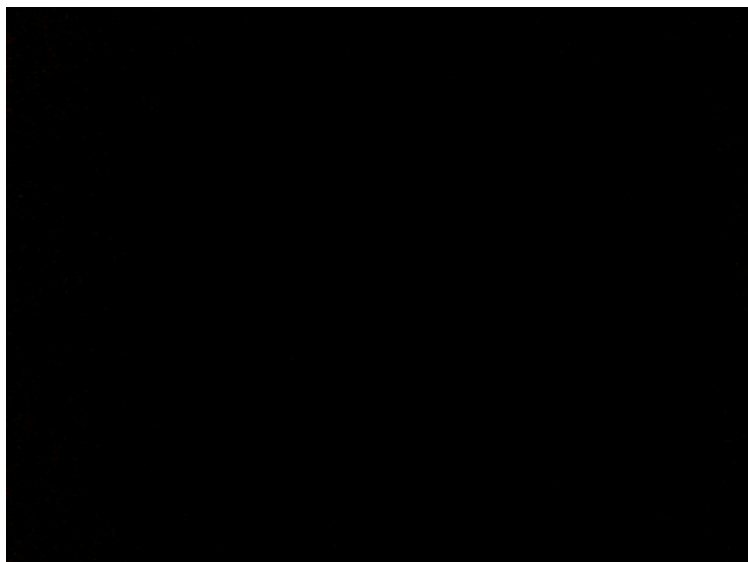
Until it will be completely black!
